

PART 15 JUSTICE MARY ANN BRIGANTTI – AMENDED RULES

In compliance with Administrative Order 85/20, Part 15 has re-activated its settlement conference/ADR calendar via Skype for Business. If you wish to have a settlement conference, please confer with all parties to come up with an agreeable date/time, and e-mail the request to Judge Brigantti's law clerk Scott Krompinger at skrompinger@nycourts.gov. In the request, please include the case name, index number, the names and contact number for the attorneys, and please confirm that you are able to receive a Skype For Business call. If you are unable to participate via Skype, please let us know and other arrangements can be made to accommodate you.

Be advised that additional vertical calendars are being arranged with specific carriers as well as plaintiff's firms. If you have a case inventory that would benefit from a vertical calendar day, please advise the Court at the above e-mail.

Please make every effort to resolve discovery disputes without the need for Court intervention (see generally, 22 NYCRR 202.7[c]). In the event that you require Court intervention, please e-mail a request for a conference to Scott Krompinger at the above address. Include the case name, index number, and a brief description of the issue. If applicable, also include a copy of the most recent compliance conference order/stipulation. Please make sure to copy all other parties in the case on any e-mail sent to the Court.

Motions submitted as of March 22, 2020 are being decided, however decisions will not be entered until clerk support is available for entry of non-emergency decisions/orders. Please contact the Court immediately, via the above e-mail, if there has been any developments in a case that would affect the resolution of a pending motion (i.e., settlement, stipulation to adjourn, withdrawal, etc.).

Finally, do not hesitate to inquire about any pending matter before the Court. While physical access to Chambers is very limited, we will make every effort to respond to queries and resolve any issues that require Court assistance.
