Plaintiff's counsel must make all arrangements to have the infant and the parent/natural guardian appear via remotely/virtually on the hearing date.

PROTOCOL: SKYPE HEARINGS AND/OR CONFERENCES

- 1. All lawyers and litigants should make every effort to appear via video.
- 2. All lawyers and litigants should identify themselves at the beginning of each appearance.
- 3. All microphones should be muted when not speaking.
- 4. All video camera should be on and engaged.
- Courtroom rules apply- speak one at a time and do not interrupt other speakers, including the Judge.
- 6. Maintain courtroom decorum. Background noise should be eliminated
- Recording the proceeding by anyone other than the Judge, Court Reporter or Court Personnel is PROHIBITED.
